Dr. Elizabeth W. Boyer is an Associate Professor of Water Resources in the Department of Ecosystem Science and Management at the Pennsylvania State University. She serves as Director of the Pennsylvania Water Resources Research Center, and as Assistant Director of Penn State Institutes of Energy & the Environment. Prior to her current position, Boyer served on the faculty at the State University of New York at Syracuse and at the University of California at Berkeley. She holds a B.S. degree in Geography from the Pennsylvania State University, and M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in Environmental Sciences from the University of Virginia. Dr. Boyer's work focuses on hydrological and biogeochemical processes that affect water resources. Her research explores the status and trends of water quality of streams, rivers, and estuaries in response to factors such as atmospheric deposition, climatic variability, land-use, and watershed management
