## **Correctness — 60%**

**Proper Execution** The code executes properly without any crashes or glitches.

**Story or Refactoring Complete** The code implements the stories as outlined in the previous week. If the stories were not completed, it was because there was some significant refactoring. If you needed to change a story without refactoring, you checked with me first.

## **Testing — 20%**

There are many unit tests. Make use of the MVC design pattern so that your model is easy to test. The tests all run successfully.

## **Clarity — 20%**

**Easy to Read** The code should be easy to read. Someone looking at the code for the first time should be able to figure out what's going on.

**Good Names** Variable names, method names and class names are well chosen.

**Formatting** You have followed conventions for formatting code. (Xcode will format code for you. Don't fight it.)
