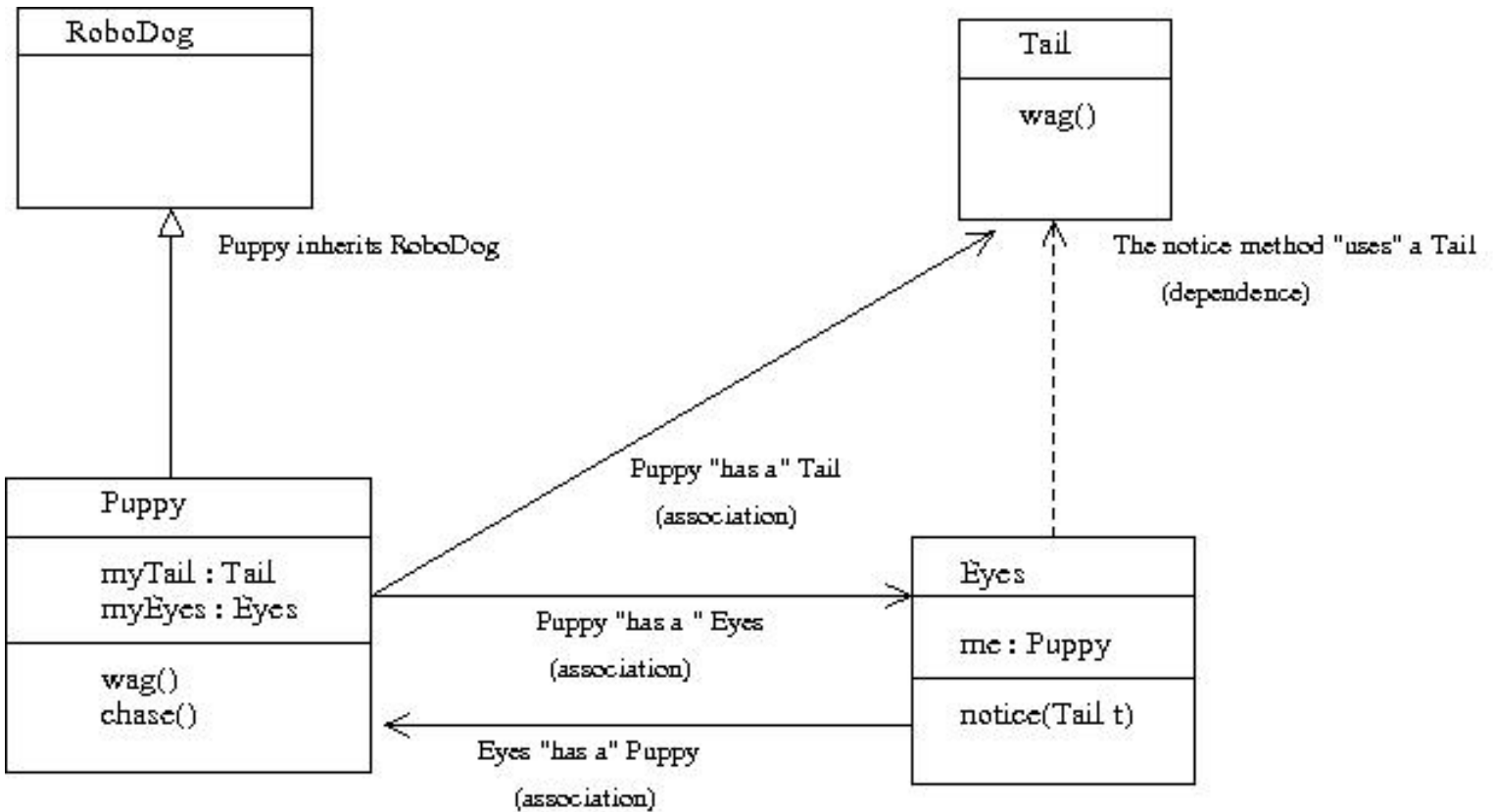


ANSWER KEY
