The recently formed Lewisburg Photography Club will hold their next meeting on Thursday February 23, 2017, from 7-9 pm at Urban Post, 308 Market Street, Lewisburg, PA. Since many of the new members are novices, the Club decided to start with an educational focus to bring everyone on board.

Do you keep your camera on Auto?

Speaker Dr. Daniel C. Hyde of Lewisburg

During the meeting's first hour, Dan will discuss camera basics (aperture, shutter speed, and ISO) and how to use these features for more control in your shots. More control leads to more creativity! Also, Dan will introduce a large topic: How to improve your photos' composition.

During the remaining time, we will break for light refreshments and have a chance to meet and chat with each other. Also, Dan will gather us back together to view any submitted images of this month's Photo Quest.

What's a Photo Quest? To encourage members to practice shooting and to grow in their photography skills, we plan to challenge you each month to use your imagination and photography skills to capture images that portray your interpretation of the month's assigned theme. Those members who wish to participate should submit one or two jpeg images at a resolution of 1024 pixels on the longest side. These images will be viewed at the next meeting. This is not a competition but a chance for you to show the group your creativity and interpretation of the theme. It will be an opportunity for the rest of us to view the theme in a new light. We encourage members at all skill levels to participate in this low stress but fun way to learn the art of photography.

We will not use the images submitted to a Photo Quest in any other way than to display them at the meeting. After the meeting, members may wish to upload their Photo Quest images to the Club's Flickr account.

The theme for our February 23rd meeting is "Winter" and your two submissions should be submitted by email to Dan Hyde by 5 pm Tuesday February 21.
