Accessing the Bucknell University Linux System on Mac OS X

- 1. Open the program X11, which is located in /Applications/Utilities in Mac OS X.
- 2. Type ssh -X username@linuxremote.eg.bucknell.edu, where "username" should be replaced by your own Bucknell username. Hit return.
- 3. Enter your Bucknell password and hit return.
- 4. You should now be logged in to linux remotely. The xterm window now functions in the same way as a linux Terminal, and is capable of running utilities such as emacs and vim, and compilers such as g++.
- 5. At the end of your session, type exit.
