#### Goal:

convey ideas and concepts

- → be clear
- ---- get your audience interested

## **Preparation:**

- know subject (content same as first paper)
- slides (see more below)
- demo (if possible)
- practice (aloud, alone & for friend, time yourself)

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#### **Oral Presentation:**

- volume
- right pace
- ▶ conversational style (do not just read, but scientific jargon → difficult)
- vary intonation, stresses and pacing

# Non-Verbal (Body):

- use pointer
- eye contact
- facial expressions, gestures
- posture, breathing

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### Slides:

- ▶ latex beamer (intro today) (or similar tool e.g. powerpoint)
- ▶ main point?
- ► audience?
- ▶ large enough font
- use colors meaningful
- content same as first paper: outline, intro & background, model, (simulation methods), summary
- repeat main points
- clear transitions (coherent thread)
