Goal:

convey ideas and concepts

- → be clear
- → get your audience interested

Preparation:

- know subject (content same as project II paper)
- slides (see more below)
- demo (if possible)
- practice (aloud, alone & for friend, time yourself)

Talks

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Oral Presentation:

- volume
- right pace
- speak freely (do not just read, learn scientific jargon)
- vary intonation, stresses and pacing

Non-Verbal (Body):

- use pointer
- eye contact
- facial expressions, gestures
- posture, breathing

Talks

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Slides:

- PowerPoint (or any tool like it)
- ► main point?
- ► audience?
- large enough font
- solid background (not distracting)
- use colors meaningful
- content same as project II paper: outline, background (historic, scientific, ...), main part, summary
- repeat main points
- clear transitions (coherent thread)
