Read: Hand-Out "What Motivates Scientists?" (also on blackboard)

1. Summarize the reading "What Motivates Scientists". Include in your summary your thoughts about the text (deeper reflection than only summary).
2. Bibliography for your project III is due (include answer in your entry on our webpage). For the bibliography find at least one book about your scientist and two journal articles written by your scientist (e.g. in journal Physical Review Letters, Nature, ...). Goal is that you will have material to learn about the life and the science of your scientist. To be able to understand the science of your scientist you should also (in addition to book(s) and journal articles) find corresponding textbooks (e.g. for J. Goodall you might need general animal behavior books to be able to put into context the major achievements of J. Goodall, for C. Sagan you might need further textbooks on astronomy besides C. Sagan's Cosmos). The bibliography is due already for Monday, because for some of the books and articles you might need an Interlibrary Loan (ILL) which takes time. One bibliography per group is fine (please indicate in your entry your group partner).
