#### Goal:

convey ideas and concepts

- $\longrightarrow$  be clear
- → get your audience interested

# **Preparation:**

- know subject (content same as first paper)
- slides (see more below)
- demo (only if possible)
- practice (aloud, alone & for friend, time yourself)

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## **Oral Presentation:**

- volume
- right pace
- conversational style (do not just read, but use scientific jargon
  - ightarrow difficult ightarrow practice)
- vary intonation, stresses and pacing

# Non-Verbal (Body):

- use pointer
- eye contact
- ► facial expressions, gestures
- posture, breathing

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## Slides:

- latex beamer (intro today) (or similar tool e.g. powerpoint)
- main point?
- audience?
- ► large enough font
- use colors meaningful (e.g. no distracting background)
- content for
  - mini-project I: same as mini-project paper
  - main project talks: same as first main project paper: outline, intro & background, model, (simulation methods), summary
- repeat main points
- clear transitions (coherent thread)
