

During the design phase of each project, you should use CRC cards. They really do help you think about a design.

CRC stands for "Class, Responsibilities and Collaborations." CRC cards are used as a design tool for Object-Oriented Design (OOD).

We suggest blank 3x5 cards. One card for each class that is organized as below:

CLASS NAME	SUPER CLASS NAME
RESPONSIBILITIES	COLLABORATIONS
<b>State</b> -What information must be maintained by object?	What objects and their methods does the class use to fulfill its responsibilities?
<b>Behavior</b> -What actions must object be able to perform?	Write collaborations as the <b>messages</b> needed to be sent.

The Form of a CRC Card

The designer draws a T on the blank card and fills in the class name, super class name at the top and the answers to the three design questions.

A pack of 100 3x5 blank cards cost about \$1 in bookstore.
