

Accessing the Bucknell University Linux System on Mac OS X

1. Open the program X11, which is located in /Applications/Utilities in Mac OS X.
2. Type `ssh -Y username@linuxremote1.eg.bucknell.edu`, where “username” should be replaced by your own Bucknell username. Hit return.
3. Enter your Bucknell password and hit return.
4. You should now be logged in to linux remotely. The xterm window now functions in the same way as a linux Terminal, and is capable of running utilities such as emacs and vim, and compilers such as g++.
5. At the end of your session, type `exit`.
